DECISION AND ORDER REMANDING CASE

A hearing on this case was held in Atlanta, Georgia on February 15, 2005. The General Counsel has submitted a motion to remand the case to the Regional Office so as to allow for the approval of the withdrawal of the underlying unfair labor practice charge pursuant to a settlement.
