

CASE DIGEST: *SSA, 74 FLRA 359 (2026)*

The Arbitrator found that a letter of reprimand issued to the grievant would expire after one year, but the Arbitrator directed the Agency to remove it from the grievant's personnel file before then. The Agency filed exceptions. After the expiration date for the letter of reprimand passed, the Authority directed the Agency to explain whether its exceptions were moot. The Agency acknowledged that the exceptions were moot and requested their dismissal. Consequently, the Authority dismissed the exceptions.
