

CASE DIGEST: *NTEU and U.S. DHS, CBP*, 0-NG-3528-REC, 74 FLRA 464
(2026) (Member Wagner dissenting)

The Union moved that the Authority reconsider its decision in *NTEU*, 72 FLRA 752 (2022) (Chairman DuBester concurring in part, dissenting in part). The motion merely disagreed with, or attempted to relitigate, conclusions reached by the Authority, and the bases on which they were reached. Because the Union’s motion did not establish extraordinary circumstances warranting reconsideration, the Authority denied it.

Member Wagner dissented, stating that she would find that the majority in *NTEU* committed legal error by ignoring certain evidence in conducting its legal analysis. Thus, she would grant the motion for reconsideration.
